Hon'ble High Court passed interim order on 7th July 2015 for provisional allotment of students to SMBT Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre. Accordingly with reference to the Interim Order of Hon'ble High Court provisional allotment is being declared to SMBT Institute of Medical Sciences & Research Centre, Dhamangaon, Tal Igatpuri Dist. Nashik, Subject to the following conditions

The College Authorities and all the students provisionally allotted to go through the order of Hon'ble High Court carefully & strictly comply with accordingly.

VI. by way of ad-interim relief, we allow petitioners-institute to provisionally admit the students for 1st year MBBS course for academic year 2015-16 to the extent the permission granted in previous year by respondent No. 1 (Union of India), subject to further orders of this Court and decision to be taken by respondent No. 1 pursuant to order/direction given by this Court on following conditions.

- (a) The provisional admission of the students shall be made with written intimation and acknowledgement to be obtained from each of the students that they are made aware that their provisional admission shall be subject to further orders of this Court as well as the decision to be taken by respondent No. 1(Union of India) pursuant to order passed by this Court and they will not entitle to claim any equity on the basis of provisional admission.
- (b) The petitioners shall file an undertaking that in the event of any order passed by this Court or the decision by the Union of India not to grant renewal for the academic year 2015-16, the petitioners shall refund the entire fees collected from the students to the respective students and abide by the decision to be taken by respondent No. 1 (Union of India), in the matter & liable for all consequences to be followed by decision of respondent No. 1.
